Note: California fully implemented the Affordable Care Act (ACA) in 2014, expanding Medi-Cal to adults under age 65 without dependent children who meet income requirements (up to 138% FPL) and immigration eligibility criteria. The number of adults who would be at risk of losing Medi-Cal coverage due to work requirements could be lower depending on the data matching that California can use to automatically exempt enrollees based on parenthood or wage data (2.3 million - 3.5 million people).
